Scrapbook Event in Parish Hall on April 14

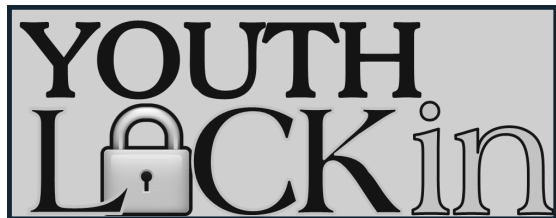

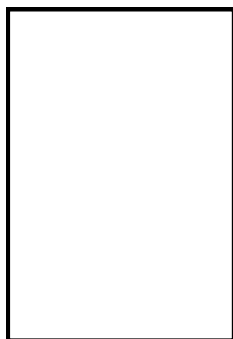
