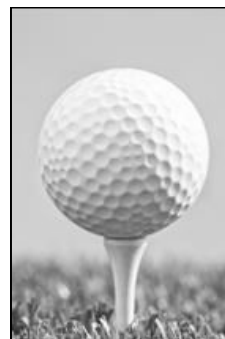
New Directory Picture Sign Up Is Next Sunday
